## DUCK HUNTING INFORMATION

### **Burbank Goose: Hunting at Paul's Ponds**

Our guide service will take you to an exclusive duck hunting area, know as

**"Green Heads Only, at Paul's Ponds \* "**.

Paul's Ponds has been featured in TV shows and in the 2003 Primos Video, **Truth 2-Incoming**. This is a phenomenal area where at times, when the mallards blanket the ponds, there should be a sign that says  
*"No More there Room!"*

Our professional guides will provide opportunities for shooting along with being able to see the birds work the area.

Hunt the proven ponds, which have provided success all season long, even until the last day the last couple of years. Why, because we do not pressure the birds all day long and have lots of feed to hold birds all season long.



Meeting time: At Burbank for ducks we have a delayed meeting time. Please check with the office the day or two before the hunt. The time can vary from 9:00 to 10AM. Yes, this is correct & proven!

Shells: **Bring 1 boxes of shells, not to exceed 2 ¾"** . This is to protect the overall quality of the hunting. The longer shells create too much noise, or sound reverberation, that disturbs all waterfowl, plus the ducks are in close. #2 shot size is recommended. Paul's favorite shells are Remington Hevi-shot.

Boots: Waders are not required, however many like them in the cold weather. The pond is not deep. High rubber boots are recommended, such as farm work boots.

Clothes: Quiet tan or beige 'no noise' clothes. Wear layers of warm clothes in fleece or other new silent fabrics. The setting is cattail and reeds. Face covering is preferred, because we do not want the wildlife to see you! However, the blinds offer excellent visibility to see the wildlife, which makes the hunt more exciting.

Blinds: You will be hunting in Maximus 'Deadly Duck Blinds'. They are full above ground blinds that offer excellent shooting ease, because you will be sitting on 'comfortable' chairs.

Dogs: The first to schedule will be given priority to bring their dog. Also we need to know your dogs experience and ability as a retriever. If you are not sure of your dog's ability, we will bring ours as a back up and leave in the truck till needed. Dogs are needed to retrieve, and if they are not skilled or obedient, they can limit your opportunities. We need to be able to retrieve all hit birds, plus not have the dog jump before the shots.

\*1. Each year we take voluntary contributions for all Susie's at \$5 each, which we donate to conservation groups to preserve and enhance wildlife, such as Ducks Unlimited and Washington Waterfowlers.

\*2. Combo hunts consists of first goose hunting, and then duck hunting (subject to availability that day- which may not be known till the day of your hunt). We execute 95% of the scheduled duck hunts, and will do everything possible to accommodate you.
